

## When calling 911 from a cell phone...

Your call will go to the 911 center of the cell tower it connects to. This tower may not be in the same community, response area, or even state as you are in. It is important the person receiving your call for help knows where you are. The information on the other side of this card will help provide the direction to the call taker to help you get responders as soon as possible.

1. State your location including city, township, county and state. (Example: I am in Anderson Township, Hamilton County, Ohio)
2. Give the exact address if possible.
3. State your emergency, what has happened and who is involved.
4. Give any information requested and stay on the line until the dispatcher releases you.
