



Drop Box Takes Unwanted Meds

A collection bin for unwanted prescriptions and over-the-counter medications is open weekdays at the District 5 Substation on Beechmont Avenue.

As part of the Ohio Prescription Drug Drop Box Program, the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office offers this convenient drop-off site Monday thru Friday, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the station, 7954 Beechmont Ave. Please, no aerosols, liquids or needles.

It's important to correctly dispose of unwanted medicines. Consider this: Sewage systems cannot remove these medicines from water that is released into lakes, rivers or oceans. Fish and other aquatic animals have shown adverse effects from medicines in the water. Also, very small amounts of medicine have been found in drinking water.
