

**BOARD OF TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES

The Board of Township Trustees met in regular session at 7:00 p.m. this 17th day of June, 2010, with the following members present:

Ms. Reis introduced the following resolution and moved its passage:

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-0617-08
ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR INTRODUCING HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES
ON TOWNSHIP STREETS**

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 94-0721-01, this Board of Township Trustees adopted certain parking regulations, and provided therein that "parking shall be prohibited on either side or both sides of any township street or county road at a place where the Board of [Township] Trustees by resolution finds such parking would be hazardous or contrary to the public safety and welfare;" and,

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) calls for reasonable accommodations to be made with regards to accommodations for persons with disabilities; and,

WHEREAS, there are several properties in Anderson Township, where there exist multiple residential units on a piece of single family zoned property, and which do not have an off street parking space, nor legal building setback to allow the installation of such a space, and,

WHEREAS, without the existence of off street parking, on-street handicapped parking may provide the best option to ensure accessibility for the residential housing unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby amends Resolution 94-0721-01 to allow for the Public Works Director, after consultation with the Fire & Rescue Department and Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, to install an on-street handicapped parking space if the following standards are met:

- The subject property lacks required off street parking.
- The construction of such off street parking is not feasible due to building placement, topography, limited side or rear yard access, and/or other regulatory constraints.
- The space is directly in front of the requester's residence (i.e. not across the street)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the aforementioned standards are met, a requestor must be the property owner of record per the Hamilton County Auditor, and may be required to pay a fee of up to \$150 to account for the cost of creating such a parking area; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the user of said space terminates residence at the subject property for thirty (30) days or more, the space may be removed by direction of the Public Works Director

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board of Township Trustees initiates the adoption of the amendments to the Anderson Township Zoning Resolution contained in Exhibits A and B hereto, which are hereby incorporated in and made parts of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution as it may be amended shall become part of the Anderson Township Zoning Resolution upon recommendations, review, hearings, amendments and final decision of this Board as prescribed by the Anderson Township Zoning Resolution and the Revised Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the preambles hereto are and shall for all purposes be construed to be integral and operative parts of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including (without implied limitation) Revised Code Section 121.22, except as otherwise permitted thereby.


Mr. O'Brien seconded the motion, and the roll being called being called upon the question of passage, the vote resulted as follows:
